HOW DID Y O U come to know  
THE T R U T H ?

Do you really THANK GOD that He has opened your mind to HIS TRUTH? Is it precious--of SUPER value to you? Or do you feel like trampling it under-foot as a sow would trample pearls or diamonds into the mud?

This thought came while reading a letter from a member in England. It is a VERY RARE THING for my eyes to see a letter like this, though there are many THOUSANDS who have received the SAME TRUTHS as this member.

It is a rather long letter, so I shall reprint here certain pertinent portions. He writes:

Dear Mr. Armstrong:

I very much appreciate the opportunity to write directly to Christ's apostle, and in just a little way to thank you for the tremendous example you are setting us and, above all, to thank you for God's truth....

Mr. Armstrong, it becomes clearer with every passing month what an enormous debt we owe you!" (He owes it to GOD). "When I reflect on the precious truths of God's Word--the knowledge of what man's future is, the coming Kingdom of God, the spirit in man, the history of the angels, the origin of human nature, what God is, and on and on, then I am truly grateful that God has called me into HIS Church--the only church on this earth that has the truth. But, Mr. Armstrong, this Church has the truth only because Christ gave it to us through you. You are Christ's chosen and ordained apostle, and it is through you that I have learned and understood all these things. How well Christ chose, trained and prepared you for your present responsibilities--and how glad I am that you are now directly involved in running the Church day to day under Jesus Christ.

When I look back over the past three or four years I am appalled at what happened in your absence from Pasadena: of how the doctrines of God the Father--taught by Jesus Christ to His apostle--were so watered down and changed that this was scarcely God's Church any more. When I consider healing, which the Head of this Church, Jesus Christ, considered so important that it was one of the earliest doctrines that He taught you (within a year of your picking up a Bible), then I am amazed at how effectively Christ's doctrine was rejected; (and even to this very day it seems that many in the church here locally are unable to really accept healing as an unbreakable PROMISE of God; the POISON of STP has done its work too well, sir, and seems to have destroyed the living FAITH which was present in the church when I first started attending).

So, Mr. Armstrong, I daily thank God for your restoration to good health and DYNAMIC POWER. Please, keep writing powerful articles setting us straight doctrinally; we need to hear from you. I totally believe that Christ puts His truth into this church through you, and so I am looking to you more and more now than I ever have before.

How often the apostle Paul wrote to his converts that they should IMITATE him, learn from him, follow his example, observe his faith and so on. Well, the apostle Paul is now dead--but there is a living apostle of Jesus Christ! And I hope--and pray--that God will give me the understanding and strength to follow, and to imitate, His apostle in this day and age. How useful is your autobiography in this regard! Thank you for writing it, it is a goldmine of advice and examples in practical living and Christianity!

Mr. Armstrong, I find that the articles you write have a ring of truth to them. When I read them, I just know that they are right; and I am not exaggerating when I say that I literally EXULT when I read them--I really do rejoice at God's truth (although sometimes it hurts!). And so I tend to study your articles VERY CAREFULLY; I am often surprised at how much I miss the first time I read them--you pack so much into your articles! As I study, much is committed to memory (at least in general terms); my purpose is to see things as you see them--to have your mind (and hence Christ's mind) on various issues.


And that brings me to the main purpose of writing this letter.

Three or four months ago I was intensively studying your article on "How Christ Gives The Church Its Beliefs," which appeared in the November 20th, 1978, Good News. I memorized its main points, and thoroughly marked up my Bible--especially at Matthew 18:18, on the subject of binding and loosing.

I was then staggered--left literally speechless--when I read an article in the March 1979 Good News which, in my eyes at least, just plainly CONTRADICTS what Christ is saying through you!!! Whereas Chrsit teaches, through you, that binding and loosing is given only to His apostles, the author of this particular article states that the ministry has the authority to make binding and loosing decisions....

Let me add here that the particular article in question was a "REPEAT" article which had appeared several years ago in the GOOD NEWS. At that time no official doctrine had been made in the Church about "binding and loosing." I did not reread the article prior to republication in the March 1979 GOOD NEWS, and I am sure the author of the article did not recheck it, either.

I made the doctrine of "binding and loosing" official only a few months ago. I do not remember catching anything in this article that should have been edited when it first appeared several years ago. So I will personally assume any blame for this discrepancy. I should have reread this article prior to its being reprinted in the March 1979 GOOD NEWS--but since I knew it was a repeated article from several years ago, I neglected doing so. With all the day-to-day administration responsibilities over the entire globe-girdling Work, it is difficult for me to read every article in the GOOD NEWS and The PLAIN TRUTH before publication. I trust our brother-in-Christ in England, who wrote the above letter will forgive me.



CHINA TRIP SET

Mr. Stanley Rader has been in Tokyo and Peking, China the past several days, making advance arrangements for my visit to the chiefs of government in China.

Plans are now complete. I will fly first to Tokyo, then to Peking. The visit to Peking will be an OFFICIAL visit, sponsored by the People's Republic of China government. The Chinese government has even sponsored Mr. Rader's visit to set plans for mine--paying all his hotel bills, meals, transportation--everything but his laundry and long-distance telephone calls.



Since I wanted to limit my trip to Peking only, the government has insisted that he visit a few other cities in China--Nanking, Shanghai, and one or two others. They will insist that I take one short side trip to see the great Chinese wall--surely one of the world's wonders built by man.

Mr. Rader has done a superb job in making all advance arrangements--sponsored by some of my "Japanese sons"--influential members of the Japanese Diet.

I urgently ask your continued PRAYERS for my good health, and for wisdom as to what to say in China, and HOW to say it--for China is communist with no religion. I must tell their leaders of the coming WORLD GOVERNMENT--we call it THE WORLD TOMORROW--but I will not be able to tell them in Christian or Bible-sounding words. I am not going for the purpose of offending them--because God loves them as well as us--but I shall ask God to give me wisdom in what to say and how to say it. Beside meeting with the two leaders in the government of the People's Republic, a large banquet is planned with 400 or more influential and high-ranking Chinese attending.

The government of China has very graciously planned for me to occupy a comparatively new suite in a new addition to their leading hotel. The great God who loves us all has given me great favor in their eyes, and opened their hearts and minds to provide for me their best. Give God THANKS!

The trip will take place very shortly after the Feast of Tabernacles--late October or early November.

INTERNATIONAL NEWSGhana--More On the Situation There

Melvin Rhodes, our minister in Ghana, his wife Diane and their two children, returned to London on August 21st. The ultimate reason for their departure from Ghana was the fact that their visa expired and the government would not in any way renew it. It has been a problem that we have wrestled with now for some three years in that area. At long last some real progress on obtaining permanent visas for a minister in Ghana has been achieved, but until they are issued, the Rhodes have had to leave the country.

We have all along thought that it may have been possible for that visa to be issued while they were in the country. Under normal circumstances that could have been possible, but Ghana is under anything but normal circumstances at the present time.

It is said that the government (Armed Forces Revolutionary Council) will be making their final clean up campaigns in September (prior to handing over the reigns to civilian rule on October 1st). And there is even talk of more house-to-house searches as was seen immediately after the coup.

Presently, the entire country suffers the hardships of drastic food and petrol shortages. Prior to returning to England, the Rhodes had been able to procure only enough food for basically one meal a day. Since the coup much of Melvin's time has been spent in lengthy waits for petrol and food and attempting to gain visas. Not particularly productive time. However, it was encouraging time for the brethren in Ghana, as most other Europeans have up and fled the country. At least the brethren can see that the Rhodes had not deserted them because the going has been tough, but because the government has demanded that they go.

It should be possible for Melvin and Diane to return to Ghana in early October prior to the Feast of Tabernacles. If the residence permits have not been granted by that time, they can at least remain for a few weeks as visitors, prior to returning to the U.K. again. Having a residence permit will be a big aid to them as in fact they will be able to obtain multiple re-entry permits to Ghana, enabling them to travel to neighbouring Togo and/or the Cameroons, where food and supplies are plentiful.

It would be good if people could remember the brethren in Ghana. The Eternal has called some 90 Ghanaians into His Church at this time, who together with their families, will be continuing to suffer under the hardships that exist. They certainly would appreciate the prayers of the brethren.

ren around the world. Unfortunately there is little that can be done in the way of sending food to them as it would never reach them. Very little in the way of parcels gets into Ghana without being tampered with in some way.

### Australia

A postal strike at the Redfern Mail Exchange in Sydney seriously disrupted our mail receipts for July. A backlog of an estimated 30 million items of mail piled up in this central post office clearing house. During the latter half of the month this strike action by postal workers slashed the number of letters reaching us in half. Our mail count for the month was 10,223 letters received, and 25,000 booklets and articles were mailed out.

There is no doubt that the Work in Australia has been, and is being, affected by the increasing number of strikes throughout the country. One statistician reported that the number of days lost in the first quarter of this year through strike action around the nation was a massive 506,000 man hours!

Though the strike action by postal workers seriously affected the number of letters reaching us, our mail income held up surprisingly well with a +7.1% increase for July, bringing year-to-date total income to 9.8%.

While many responses to our national advertising and householder card programs are still held up in the back log of mail, nevertheless, for the month of July we were still able to add another 5000 new PLAIN TRUTH subscribers to the mailing list. The Australian PLAIN TRUTH mailing list now stands at around the 75,000 mark, and it is still growing.

Church attendance for the 57 Australian churches for July continued to be very good. July is mid-winter and traditionally, along with August, usually has the lowest church attendance because of colds and flu. But July this year again, as in the past few months, held up well--over 4700, which is good news indeed. It appears we may surpass our goal of 5000 by the end of the year.

For the past two years, I was very sick with cancer and unable to work. In September 1978 I was given three months to live.

The tumor in my stomach was 11 inches in diameter and my right kidney was crushed. I had lost 45 pounds. But with a change of diet and God's help I have survived.

In the beginning of January 1977, when this cancer was first diagnosed, I refused to go into the hospital for treatment. I changed my diet. I was doing fine and I held my own until September 1978. When I could no longer stand the pain, with coaxing from my family, I was admitted to the hospital.

Because of the tumor's huge size, the only thing the doctors could do was treat it with radiation and chemotherapy. They could not operate. I was anointed by a minister in the Springfield, Massachusetts church. The radiation treatments began. The doctors could not tell me how many treatments I would have to endure. One night before the 19th treatment and during the 19th treatment, I prayed to God. "Father, you know more about radiation than any doctor could ever know. If it be your will, please help me to get well for I have not learned enough about your ways. I have only been in your Church a very short time. I would like some time to learn more."

When the day came for the 20th treatment, the doctors found, after checking me, that the tumor had disappeared. After 3 x-rays and 4 ultrasound tests, they found no tumors, and my right kidney was back to normal as if nothing ever happened. To date, July 3, 1979, I have gained back 40 pounds and no longer am I under a doctor's care. The cancer is gone. The blood count is O.K.

### ON THE WORLD SCENE

THE WALLS COME TUMBLING DOWN: Suddenly, one crisis after another is erupting all over the Caribbean basin. It all spells big trouble for the United States, which once had little to fear from the "mañana cultures" to the south.

In a recent Pastor General's Report we examined the revolution in Nicaragua and its future impact upon neighboring countries in Central America. Suffice it to add here that the wealthy landowners in El Salvador and Guatemala--sensing the gathering storm--are sending their money out of their countries as well as buying up property in Miami. In El Salvador, leftist guerrillas, following the Sandinista rulebook, are kidnapping foreign diplomats and businessmen, financing their operations through ransom money.



In the islands of the eastern Caribbean, ferment among the tiny independent island states is rising. And everywhere, Cuba's hand is in the pot. Last March 13 a coup overthrew the government of Grenada and put a self-proclaimed "radical-leftist" regime in control of that tiny (population 106,000) republic.

Grenada's new government insists that it is neither Communist nor a Cuban satellite. But, in a move that sent tremors through the White House and State Department, it immediately turned to Havana for arms, military advisors and other aid.

The newest island trouble spot is St. Lucia (population 120,000). Three weeks ago, an election put the Labour Party in the driver's seat, ousting the United Worker's Party, which had held power for over a decade. In one of its first acts, the new left-wing government sent a group of 100 young men for training by Cuban troops on Grenada. The recruits will serve as the nucleus of a "people's revolutionary army."

While all this was going on, a Russian naval task force was steaming toward the Caribbean. The Russian objective, reported London's Daily Telegraph, "is to show the Russian flag in Cuba, in the Caribbean, and in Central America at a time when Washington is showing increasing nervousness in the aftermath of the Nicaraguan upheaval."

Senator Richard Stone, the Florida Democrat who keeps a constant watch on Russian influence in Cuba, said that the Russians have gradually stepped up the number and changed the nature of their naval visits to Cuba. The point has now been reached where these visits could not be seen as merely "port calls," since they involve Soviet missile-carrying submarines staying at Cienfuegos for up to two weeks. Reports on the latest Russian task force say that it will probably make calls at several Caribbean islands, including Grenada.

Since last March, Soviet pilots have assumed responsibility for much of Cuba's air defenses, freeing up Cuban pilots for service in Ethiopia, Angola, Afghanistan and elsewhere.

In a few days, beginning September 3, Cuba will be hosting the sixth "non-aligned" summit conference in Havana--a "somber joke" reports the Daily Telegraph's Robert Moss who adds that "Dr. Fidel Castro's Cuba is about as non-aligned as a sign showing the direction of a one-way street. Moscow has no more obedient or effective satellite."

Castro would like to swing the non-aligned countries--those in the third world supposedly neutral between the West and the Soviet bloc--into firm anti-U.S., anti-West posture.

Among the propaganda themes that figure high on the agenda are: Increased support for the "liberation struggles" in southern Africa and the world-wide struggle against "Zionism, racism and imperialism;" full recognition of the Palestine Liberation Organization; world disarmament (the code word for unilateral Western disarmament); and condemnation of the Egyptian-Israeli peace process and the expulsion of Egypt from the non-aligned movement.

In recent weeks the Cubans have distributed to all the delegations a basic working document to be used for the non-aligned summit. The United States and Western "imperialism" are condemned on page after page.

America's enemies, large and small (Cuba has less than 10 million people!) are becoming bolder than ever before as God's protection is progressively removed from His people, due to their sins.

Psalms 89, verses 38 through 43 reads (RSV): "But now thou hast cast off and rejected, thou art full of wrath against thy anointed. Thou hast renounced the covenant with thy servant; thou hast defiled his crown in the dust. Thou hast breached all his walls; thou hast laid his strongholds in ruins. All that pass by despoil him; he has become the scorn of his neighbors. Thou hast exalted the right hand of his foes; thou hast made all his enemies rejoice. Yea, thou hast turned back the edge of his sword, and thou hast not made him stand in battle."
