### Information About Deaf Brethren

### International News

Canada The financial picture for June is considerably better than the one for May. We registered a 15.7% increase over June of last year, bringing our year-to-date figure to a plus 12.9%.

This last month has seen the office staff very busy handling the regular mail plus the extra work generated by our magazine advertising campaign. The latest figures are as follows:

June also saw us mail out Mr. Armstrong's semiannual letter offering the WONDERFUL WORLD TOMORROW and the UNITED STATES AND BRITAIN IN PROPHECY booklets. The latter continues to be one of our most popular booklets. In the first six months of this year we have mailed out over 22,000. This will probably jump considerably with the advertising of it in the letter. The other most requested booklets of the first six months are as follows:

### PUBLISHING SERVICES UPDATE

God is continuing to bless Mr. Armstrong's efforts to put the Church back on the right track by granting ever-increasing growth in PT subscriptions. Thanks to Mr. Armstrong's very dynamic and revitalized television program and the diligent efforts by our 7,000-member team of newsstand representatives, during the first six months of 1982 over 700,000 new subscribers have been added to the PT mailing list. This increase is already 80% of the total number added during all of 1981. It also represents the same number of subscribers added in 1979 and 1980 combined!

More than 70% of all new subscribers this year have come from newsstands, TV programs, and blow-in cards. This increase of new subscribers has raised the U.S. subscription level to 1,891,000 with the August issue.

Worldwide circulation at this point, including newsstands, is at 4,820,000. It is interesting to note that many of the new subscribers are coming from the major metropolitan areas of the U.S. These areas have historically yielded few subscribers. For example, the New York area has advanced 46 places in the past nine months in rank of PT penetration. Chicago and Philadelphia have increased 56 and 54 places in rank respectively. These advances reflect the substantial increase in media coverage for these areas from TV, newsstands and display items.

The most spectacular increase has been in the Hartford/New Haven area, which has risen in rank of PT penetration 102 places. It is interesting to note that the Hartford/New Haven Church area distributes the largest number of PT newsstand magazines in the U.S.

We are now reaching one out of every 25 households in the United States. At this rate of growth, we should reach the five million circulation level by the end of 1982.

### ON THE WORLD SCENE

HERPES--PROMISCUITY'S PAINFUL PENALTY A most remarkable article appeared in this week's (August 2, 1982) issue of TIME magazine. In fact, at least in the North American edition, it was the cover story, titled "The New Scarlet Letter," subtitled: "Herpes, an incurable virus, threatens to undo the sexual revolution."

It would be worthwhile for all in the ministry to obtain a copy of this issue, or at least a photocopy of the article from a nearby public library. For those around the world who are unable to do so, I felt it would be good to summarize it here, along with some comments and quotes. The article begins as follows:

After chastity slouched off into exile in the '60s, the sexual revolution encountered little resistance. Indeed, in the age of the Pill, Penthouse Pets and porn-movie cassettes, the revolution looked so sturdily permanent that sex seemed to subside into a simple consumer item. Now, suddenly...herpes, an ancient viral infection that can be transmitted during sex, recurs fitfully and cannot be cured...has emerged from relative obscurity and exploded into a full-fledged epidemic. "The truth about life in the United States in the 1980s," says Dr. Kevin Murphy of Dallas, one of the nation's leading herpes researchers, "is that if you are going to have sex, you are going to have to take the risk of getting herpes."

An estimated 20 million Americans now have genital herpes, with as many as half a million new cases expected this year.... Those remarkable numbers are altering sexual rites in America, changing courtship patterns, sending thousands of sufferers spinning into months of depression and self-exile and delivering a numbing blow to the one-night stand. The herpes counterrevolution may be ushering a reluctant, grudging chastity back into fashion. Eight years ago, Alex Comfort, the expansive apostle of coitus [and author of JOY OF SEX] could say of sex: "There is nothing to be afraid of and never was." Now, in the Age of Herpes, Playboy

employees jokingly refer to the swimming facilities at Hugh Hefner's Los Angeles mansion as "the herpes pool."...Flesh Merchant Al Goldstein, editor of [unprintable] magazine, says glumly, "It may be there is a god in heaven carving out his pound of flesh for all our joys."

Why the dramatic rise now in the incidence of herpes? Sexual freedom is obviously implicated. "With herpes, every new case is added to the pool," says Dr. Yehudi Felman, a New York City VD specialist. "The increase is exponential after a while." Not only are more people indulging in sex, they are also more active --starting younger, marrying later, divorcing more often. The wider acceptance of oral sex has also played a role. Herpes Type I produces cold sores in the mouth; Herpes II, genital lesions. [But Herpes I can become a venereal disease if spread there through oral sex. This practice, in fact spreads both viruses in each direction.]

Many swingers have dropped out because of herpes. And a trip to a prostitute is a high-stakes gamble....The epidemic has clearly made married philanderers extremely wary. Few things cool extra-marital ardor like the specter of passing on an incurable disease to a mate and then having to explain where it came from....Wives now give husbands smiling lectures on the ravages of the disease to keep them faithful....

The herpes virus itself is a particularly perplexing and defiant villain, as described in TIME's follow-up article, "Battling an Elusive Invader." It has been labeled "the ultimate parasite." It could also be called a most intimate parasite. Once herpes has found its way into your system, says Dr. Harold Kessler, a Chicago specialist in infectious diseases, "it's your virus for life." It does this by taking over the protein-producing apparatus of the host cell, initiating what one expert calls a "biological coup d'etat."

Once the initial attack has been brought under control by the body's immunological system, the virus retreats, in the case of genital herpes, to the sacral ganglia which is a cluster of nerve cells near the base of the spinal cord. Here the herpes simplex virus lodges safely beyond the reach of the body's immune system and enters a latent stage.

The virus reinfects the original site capriciously, sometimes twice a month, causing discomfoting sores and lesions, sometimes (though rarely) as seldom as once a decade. Since physical and emotional stress seems the most likely trigger to reinfection, herpes sufferers try to lead tranquil lives, some practicing yoga.

Genital herpes has its particularly dangerous manifestations also, especially to the unborn. Should genital herpes recur in the final weeks of pregnancy, look out! It is estimated that about half of newborns pick up the disease when traversing the birth canal. Of those infected, up to 60% die, and for the survivors there is a 50% risk of blindness or brain damage!

The Herpes simplex virus has remarkably altered the "etiquette" of promiscuous behavior, notes the TIME special report:

...A direct question ("You don't have herpes, do you?") is regarded as tacky. Standard openings have evolved. "You would tell me if you had anything I could catch, wouldn't you?" is admired for its implication of trust and its we're-in-this-together coziness....

When or whether to tell a date that you have herpes is a thorny matter....Psychotherapist [Michael] Herships [came up with a] solution: if you are not having an attack of herpes at the time, then don't tell, because the risk of transmission is low. [This amounts to a kind of "herpes rhythm method," doesn't it?] Surprisingly, many doctors counsel silence on the first encounter, mostly because their patients' psyches are shaky....Says another doctor: "Every time you kiss someone good night, do you tell them you sometimes get cold sores on your mouth?"

Herpetics (those who have the disease) can do little but try to control the negative emotions and stress that usually trigger the recurring attacks. Of course, medical science is attempting to come up with either a vaccine or a wonder drug to circumvent the built-in penalty for violating the Seventh Commandment. Right now there is an international search underway for a herpes vaccine. There are said to be "promising" vaccines being tested. As far as drugs to control the virus once it is contracted, prospects are bleaker. Once the virus has tunneled into the ganglia "hide out," it may be too late. Says one specialist: "You would need a pretty remarkable drug to attack the virus genes without damaging the host cells." Of course, medical science is cut off from the knowledge and power of God who is the only one who can cure (heal) herpes--once a person truly repents of transgressing God's Laws in this aspect of life.

The TIME article nowhere counsels a return to a moral "lifestyle." A biblical-based morality is subtly scorned, as evidenced by a reference to herpes as "Jerry Falwell's revenge" (Falwell is a TV preacher who heads the so-called Moral Majority movement in America) and the less subtle quote from Al Goldstein ("a god in heaven carving out his pound of flesh for all our joys"). The TIME article does admit that the herpes epidemic may be ushering in a time of "reluctant, grudging chastity." Oh yes, carnal mankind wants to have "fun" without paying the penalty and bemoans the fact that it can't "have it both ways." But even TIME is forced to admit that our promiscuous age is being snapped back into a sense of reality. It concludes by stating:

For now, herpes cannot be defeated, only cozened into an uneasy, lifelong truce....But perhaps not so unhappily, it may be a prime mover in helping to bring to a close an era of mindless promiscuity. The monogamous now have one more reason to remain so. For all the distress it has brought, the troublesome little bug may inadvertently be ushering in a period in which sex is linked more firmly to commitment and trust.

#### Meanwhile, the Churches Veer Farther From the Truth

TIME magazine and other popular publications can't be expected to counsel the public to go the right way. But then, who does act as wise counsel except God's Church? Certainly not this world's churches! Here is an article from the TIMES of London, June 10, 1982, discussing one church's "enlightened" new outlook regarding homosexuality.



A third attempt is to be made this month to persuade the Methodist Conference to accept a statement that takes a tolerant view of homosexual relationships. In 1979 and 1980 reports reaching similar conclusions were referred back for further consideration. They both ran into opposition on the ground that their attitude to homosexual conduct was incompatible with biblical teaching.

The latest report, published today, records that two views exist in the church and adds that a majority of those on the working party which produced it felt that biblical teaching on homosexuality should be reinterpreted in the light of modern insights.

The biblical authors considered that God had created all people as heterosexual by nature. Hence homosexuality was contrary to God's design. It was now understood, the report said, that some people are by nature homosexual, and "we must consider seriously the possibility that homosexuality is part of God's process of creative design."

A majority of the working party therefore concludes, as did the two earlier reports, that homosexual and heterosexual relationships should both be valued according to the presence or absence of love. Therefore the choice of a homosexual relationship, including "genital expression," is to be expected as one that Christians may responsibly make. The working party was united in believing that men and women of a homosexual nature should not be barred from Christian ministry or church office.

Elsewhere in the report the working party also urges a tolerant attitude towards people who, whether homosexual or heterosexual, live together in transient relationships.

In other words, even "slumming around" is to be viewed with tolerance. Anyway, I felt that a diversion from our normal coverage of world events in order to delve into this social topic would prove helpful. It certainly shows the immutability and wonder of God's Law and how it cannot be broken without paying a penalty.

"Yea, let God be true, but every man a liar"--including the sex gurus of this age such as Alex Comfort and Hugh Hefner with his insidious "Playboy Philosophy," which he propounded continuously in his publication, setting much of the tone for contemporary moral standards. Just because God's Law didn't exact an immediate penalty for violation, the hucksters of hedonism thought there was no penalty. They couldn't see that genital herpes and the large array of other wildly explosive STD's--sexually-transmissible diseases--must first build up a large reservoir of affected victims before their full impact would be felt. How much easier it is to learn truth by obeying God's Law rather than through painful experience.
